# Manitoba Alpine Ski Division Inc. Respect in Sport Policy

## **Purpose of the Policy:**

- 1. The Manitoba Alpine Ski Division Inc. (MASD) is committed to creating a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. Coaches have a responsibility to create a sporting environment that is free of harassment and abuse.
- MASD requires that all coaches participating in Alpine Skiing complete the Respect in Sport (RIS) program and maintain RIS certified status (5-year term) as required by Sport Manitoba.

# **Scope and Application:**

- 1. The policy applies to all coaches registered with, or named on an official sport roster, or under the jurisdiction of MASD.
- Any coach not having completed the RIS program or having maintained certified status in the timeframe established by Sport Manitoba and MASD may be removed as a coach until such time that the RIS course is completed and/or maintain RIS certification.

#### **Enforcement:**

Non-compliance of this policy may result in further discipline as determined by the Board of Directors or in accordance with the **Code of Conduct** policy.

## **Review and Approval:**

This policy was approved by the Board of Directors on April 15, 2025, and will be reviewed by the Executive Committee on an annual basis.
